## FROM THE EXECUTIVE TEAM

### 2018 ENROLMENTS

A reminder to let us know if a sibling is starting school next year so that we can arrange an enrolment pack for you.

Tours and information sessions will be held in May to introduce new families to our school and give them some insights into starting Preps.

Morning information sessions and tours will be held on May 16 and 18 (at 9:30am) with an evening information session on May 17 (at 7:00pm).

If you know of new families please encourage them to attend one of the sessions.

### NAPLAN

NAPLAN testing is fast approaching for Year 3 and 5 students. Please remember that NAPLAN is a point in time measurement of progress and only one piece of information in the assessment jigsaw.

Students can be prepared for NAPLAN, by being familiarised with the format and learning some simple strategies to assist when solving the problems posed in the test. Teachers reinforce the importance of asking for help when needed (teachers are able to read questions to students in the Mathematics component), making sure to read the whole question and all the answer choices, eliminating obvious incorrect answers, circling key words, skimming text for answers and checking answers at the end.

All students have also had experience at writing persuasive and narrative texts, one of which will be the task for the Writing component.

Despite this preparation, it is important to reinforce the message that this testing is simply another part of a student's work. We wish to avoid, as much as possible, students becoming anxious when doing the

tests. The important messages are to "do your best" and "do as much as you can".

The NAPLAN tests occur May 9-11. All Year 3 and 5 students participate, unless parents formally request that their child does not participate (please contact your child's teacher) or an exemption is granted.

### STUDENT ATTITUDES TO SCHOOL SURVEY

This week, our school has been involved in the Department of Education and Training's (DET) pilot of the updated Student Attitudes to School Survey. The Attitudes to School Survey is an annual student survey offered by DET to assist schools in gaining an understanding of students' perceptions and experiences of school. Our school will use the survey results to improve our students' schooling experience. Whilst this survey has been conducted for students in Grade 5/6 for a number of years, this year Grade 4 students were also included. In addition, this year's survey was conducted online for the first time – which will enable more prompt access to survey data. Along with our Killara Student Surveys that are conducted on a term by term basis in all classrooms, the Student Attitudes to School Survey is another vital tool in assisting us build student centred classrooms. The survey also provides another outlet for student voice to be heard.

### MOTHER'S DAY STALL

Once again our Parents and Friends Association (PFA) have run a successful Mother's Day Stall. Students were provided with a great range of present options – from socks to aprons to shower scrubs. There were even light up wine glasses on offer! Thank you to our parents who supported the stall by providing their children with money to spend at the stall.
