PARENT REQUESTS

As mentioned last week, we have commenced planning of our class structures for 2015. The establishment of class lists is an extremely complex matter, which involves a lengthy process of deliberation. Our aim is to establish class groups that take into account the needs of all children.

If there is information that we may not be aware of that may affect your child's class placement next year please put the details in writing <u>utilising the form provided last week (extra forms are available at the office)</u>, which we are using for the first time to assist us with managing the process. All requests must be made using the form. There is no need to fill in the form unless you have pertinent information to share.

Please remember that this is not a teacher selection process, but an opportunity to provide genuine information which may assist with your child's social and academic grouping to ensure that their needs are met. Requests for particular teachers will not be considered and teacher's names must not be included on the form.

Please return the form by Friday November 14.

It is also important to note that it is not always possible to satisfy every request. As such, needs are treated in priority order.

2015 PLANNING

Thanks to families that have let us know they will be leaving Killara for 2015. If you know you are leaving our school due to relocation or for other reasons, please advise the office or add NR on the parent request form next to the child's name.

Killara is now a very large organisation, with enrolments likely to be over 620 next year. This means that the task of organising, structuring and staffing the school is a very complex one, requiring much deliberation, thought and consultation. The first task for us is to determine (reasonably) accurate enrolment numbers for next year.

If you know of any families with children due to start Prep in 2015 who haven't enrolled yet, please encourage them to do so.

EDUCATION MAINTENANCE ALLOWANCE

It is with regret that I inform the community and particularly those who have been in receipt of EMA, that EMA will not be continuing in 2015.

As a school, we will continue to assist families in need by offering payment plans and any other assistance possible, but we will be receiving **no** extra funding so will be unable to provide financial assistance, except in exceptional circumstances.

The funds previously provided by the State Government for EMA have been distributed to schools considered to be the "neediest government schools" in the state. Killara does not meet the parameters for this.
