2026 PLANNING

To assist us with this, if you are aware of anyone who is considering sending their child to Killara next year, please encourage them to contact the school before the end of October to arrange a school tour or obtain enrolment forms. Similarly, if you will be leaving Killara next year, can you please notify the office so we can obtain a firm idea of enrolment numbers for each year level for 2026.

Our school recently underwent an Occupational Health and Safety Management System (OHSMS) assessment by Ernst & Young on behalf of the Department of Education. These audits occur once every four or five years and I would like to extend a huge thank you to our Business Manager, Emily Healey, who oversees OHS at Killara, for her efforts in preparing our school for the audit. The auditor reviewed a range of areas, including: Contractor induction, Chemical register, Working at heights, Electrical management, First Aid & CPR, Risk Registers, Staff Training & Induction (related to

workplace safety such as manual handling), Mental Health & Wellbeing - staff training and Emergency Management Planning.

Congratulations to our Volleyball Team (boys) who proudly Woodlands represented Killara at the Championships in Craigieburn this week. Coach, Ms Paige Surgeon, was extremely impressed with the team's commitment and efforts. Many thanks also to our parents for

Standard strength toothpaste


Smile Squad provides standard strength fluoride toothpaste that is generally used by ages six and over, unless recommended by a dental or trained health professional.

If your child is under six, please talk to a dental or trained health professional to find out if your child might benefit from using this toothpaste. You can also choose to put the toothpaste away until they turn six or give it to someone else in your family to use.

Do I need to attend my child's appointment?

No, you do not need to attend your child's appointment. You can attend if you would like to, and you can take your child to the community dental clinic if you prefer.
