COURTEOUS CAR PARKING

It has been drawn to our attention by Sunbury Police that some of our neighbours are concerned that their driveways are regularly being parked across. Please be aware that **finances will be issued** for this practice.

Blocking a driveway could be a serious matter if there is a medical emergency or the person who lives in the house has a medical condition, but doing so also stops them from entering or exiting their property. The practice of parking across driveways is illegal.

We remind everyone to be patient and courteous when parking and driving around the school and encourage you to consider parking further away and walking if all available parking is taken.

SEMESTER REPORTS

Complementing our on-going reporting through Compass, semester reports will be made available to parents on June 23.

Teachers have begun the task of putting the reports together to ensure you receive your child's assessment against the curriculum, along with comments relating to their learning. All reports will once again be online and you will be able to access them through Compass. As with semester one, reports will contain less information than in previous years, as we have been communicating results in a more timely manner throughout the year via the learning tasks.

Reports will include a summary page of VICTORIAN CURRICULUM levels, a general comment, student work habits and behaviour grading as well as a student self-reflection.

We remind parents to keep in touch with their child's progress, by regularly accessing Compass when learning tasks are announced.

Lily was the only competitor to spell each of her 10 words with no mistakes, and is bringing the perpetual trophy back to Killara to be displayed at school. Lily has also won a \$600 cash prize, and a \$500 grant for Killara to spend on literacy equipment. Well done, Lily!



SCHOOL COUNCIL REPORT

A busy, but fruitful, School Council meeting was held on Tuesday evening. The following items were discussed/approved:

- Expenditure and financial statements were approved for the months of March and April
- The school's Annual Report was presented and approved. This document will be placed on the school web site
- Council agreed to supplement a Planned Maintenance Program by contributing up to \$60,000 (\$121,000 funding received from DET). This project will undertake major roof repairs and internal repairs and redecorating
- Council thanked the work of the prep teachers with the Prep Information Night and Bec Gerber for her work with athletics and cross country
- Council recognised our contribution as a school to the ANZAC parade in Sunbury and the quality of the ceremony held at school
- Agreement was made to pursue new digital learning devices for the P-2 area of the school. A combination of touch screen laptop-type

computers and iPads will be purchased on a lease arrangement over 3 years

- The Education Committee presented information relating to the Victorian Curriculum and outlined some other key developments around the school, including the introduction of class libraries and the involvement of 5/6 staff in a community of practice relating to the effective teaching of Numeracy
- A new freezer for the canteen to be sourced
- A new school banner to be investigated, for use at sports events, parades and school events
- Line-marking to be re-applied throughout, dependent on cost
