YEAR 3/4 CAMP 2021 - CAMP KOOKABURRA

Please find below details of our Year 3/4 2021 Camp which will be in week 8 of Term 3. We depart for camp on Monday, August 30 and return on Wednesday, September 1.

Camps are an excellent opportunity for students to develop independence and social skills and to learn in a different setting that offers a variety of unique experiences. Camp Kookaburra will compliment many of our academic and social programs such as Health and Physical Education, Science and Humanities. All activities are conducted according to the Education Department's 'Safety in the Outdoors Guidelines' and students will be fully briefed on safety matters and appropriate use of any equipment being used.

All our year 3/4 students have the opportunity to attend this fantastic camp which is set in 60 hectares of rural bushland near Corop, Central Victoria, between the large regional towns of Bendigo and Echuca.

Dates:

The 2021 Camp is a 3 Day/2 Night Camp.

Children will need to be at school at 8:45am on **Monday**, **August 30**, **2021** for a 9:15am sharp departure. Children will return to school at approximately 3:00pm on **Wednesday**, **September 1**, **2021**

Accommodation:

Camp Kookaburra is situated in Corop, Victoria. The site caters for all our Year 3/4 students at one time, with cabins sleeping between eight to ten students each. These cabins have bunk beds and ensuite facilities. There is a dining room, large sports oval, a range of courts for sports and an indoor recreation room. Mattresses are provided, but students will need to bring their own sleeping bag, top sheet, pillow and pillowcase. Shortly before attending camp, students will be involved in a process to decide on cabin groups and be given a briefing on what activities will occur at the camp.

Program:

During the day students will have the opportunity to participate in a broad range of experiences, as mentioned above, and in the evenings we will have a movie night and a night walk.

The cost for the 2021 camp is \$275.00

This is an all-inclusive fee that includes all the accommodation, activities, travel and meals. Payments can be made in full or by instalments. To pay instalments, please contact the office staff.

Please Note: Your child cannot attend camp unless payment has been received in full.

To reserve a place for your child, please complete the attached permission form and return it to school with the deposit of \$50 by Friday, July 23rd, 2021 with the balance due by Wednesday August 18, 2021.

Medication and Dietary Requirements

Please complete the attached forms and return to school by **Wednesday August 18.** All medication needs to be clearly labelled with your child's name and the dosage required including how often to take the medication (including Panadol/Paracetamol). The Student Emergency Contact & Medical Details form and Student Code of Conduct form has been attached to this letter and are due back by **Wednesday, August 18** as well. The Medication Authority form and all medication must be handed/signed in at the school office on the morning of camp (Monday, August 30).

Parental Assistance

Parents will be needed to assist with the camp. Please think carefully before volunteering and keep in mind that your assistance is needed for all children and that you may not always be in the group in which your child is a member. Remember all children need the opportunity to develop independence and look after themselves and their belongings, so your role will be to support and assist all students.

For parents to assist with our school camp, they must ensure that they have a current Working with Children Check card and attend a child safety induction session prior to the camp. To express your interest, please return the attached form by Monday August 2.
